

# Notice

Notice is hereby given that the Parish Council of the Parish of Northmead and Winston Hills intends to apply to the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney for an ordinance to –

- (a) vary the trusts of the existing property held by the Property Trust for the general or specific purposes of the parish, so that it is henceforth held for the general purposes of the parish (clause 5);
- (b) specify how the capital of the trust may be used, distinguishing between real property and other property - described as personal property (clause 6);
- (c) provide for the application of income from the trust (clause 7);
- (d) provide for a review of the application of income provisions (clause 8) and
- (e) authorise the Property Trust to lease or license any real property comprising the trust (with the consent of parish council and except any part which is licensed or consecrated for use as a church) for a period not exceeding 5 years (clause 9).

A copy of the proposed Ordinance is annexed to this notice.

Any objections to the proposed Ordinance may be presented in accordance with the Ordinance Procedure Ordinance 1973 (as amended) to –

at any time before the expiration of 3 weeks from the date of posting of this notice.


If you do decide to send an objection, please ensure that it –
